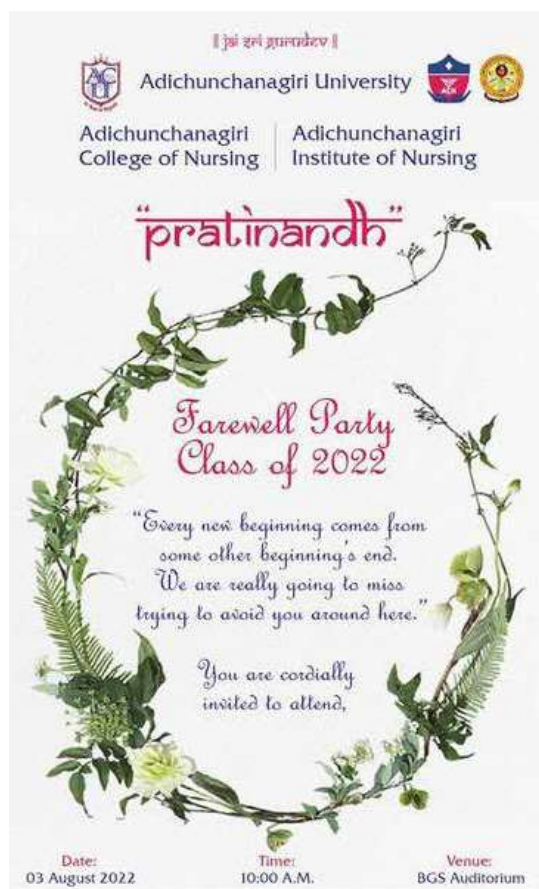
## GUEST LECTURE ON TOPIC OF SWARAJ@75
