


3. WEBINAR ON 'MANAGEMENT OF WOMEN WITH OBSTETRICAL COMPLICATIONS'




8. WEBINAR TO OBSERVE ON WORLD LEPROSY DAY




10. WEBINAR ON "LITERACY EDUCATION AND SOCIAL CONTEXT: A SOCIOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVE"










12. WEBINAR ON "ROLE OF ONCOLOGY NURSES"







14. WEBINAR ON THE OCCASION OF "DEWORMING DAY"









15. WEBINAR ON LEUKEMIA








17. AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON "SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH"








19. WEBINAR ON PERSONALITY DISORDERS








20. AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON IMPORTANCE OF VACCINATION TO LACTATING AND PREGNANT MOTHERS








21. SENSITISATION PROGRAMME ON TUBERCULOSIS









22. E-SEMINAR ON "SECURITY AND PRIVACY IN SOCIAL NETWORKING"










23. WEBINAR ON "HEARING CARE AND SAFE LISTENING"








24. SCIENTIFIC SESSION ON "DOWN SYNDROME AND ITS MANAGEMENT"








27. OBSERVING WORLD WATER DAY








31. WEBINAR ON ETIOPATHOGENESIS OF TUBERCULOSIS








33. GUEST LECTURER ON HAEMOPHILIA













40. SEMINAR ON "PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT AND NEED OF LIFE SKILL TRAINING FOR YOUTHS"









41. CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE MIDWIVES






42. PENCIL DRAWING COMPETITION








INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON DETERMINATION OF SAMPLE SIZE FOR HEALTH SCIENCES RESEARCH








CELEBRATION OF WORLD IVF DAY




GUEST LECTURE ON THE OCCASION OF WORLD HEPATITIS DAY








BREAST FEEDING AWARENESS PROGRAMME AND ROLE PLAY








CELEBRATION OF SADBHAVANA DIWAS








SCHOOL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMME








AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON MENTAL HEALTH IN VIEW OF WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY








GUEST LECTURE ON "BIO MEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT"








AUDIO-VISUAL AIDS MODEL EXHIBITION








AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON "WORLD DIABETES DAY-2022








AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON WORLD PREMATURITY DAY









CELEBRATING THE NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK








SCHOOL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMME AND NUTRITION EXHIBITION








IN SERVICE EDUCATION PROGRAMME ON "ARTERIAL BLOOD GAS ANALYSIS"
