The University is nestled in a verdant expanse of 67.3 acres at B.G. Nagara, Nagamangala Tq., in Mandya District of Karnataka. Located on the Bangalore – Mangalore National Highway No. 75, it is just 105 km from Bangalore, the state's capital. This unitary campus is renowned for its lush greenery.

Encompassing a lush and eco-friendly campus, the university showcases sustainability with over 4,000 trees and rooftop solarization. A commitment to green energy further underlines the institution's dedication to environmental responsibility.

Demonstrating environmental consciousness, the campus is plastic-free, battery-operated buggies and BI-cycles contribute to the institution's green initiative.

The campus embraces alternate energy sources with 8 solar units generating 700 kW and a 300 kg capacity Biogas plant for food waste management. Water conservation is prioritised with a 750 KLD sewage water treatment plant and 17 RO, 500 LPH water purification plants.

Adichunchanagiri Hospital and Research Center was started as a teaching hospital attached to Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences in the year 1990, Now it is under Adichunchanagiri University. It was the dream of His Holiness Bairvaikya Padmabushana Sri Sri Sri Dr Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji to build a hospital in the rural area of Javarannahalli to provide the state of the art medical services under one roof to the rural population around this place.

This hospital started as a 300 bed hospital in 1990, now it has increased upto 1200 bed Hospital with all facilities to provide the best of the care to the patient. 13 broad specialties along with round the clock Emergency services, Laboratory & Radiology Diagnostic services. Ambulance services, ICU services, Pharmacy & blood bank facility.

The hospital provides teaching facility to medical students, Nursing students, Pharmacy and Paramedical students. The excellent clinical materials with an average daily outpatient of around 1000 numbers and inpatient of around 500 - 600, which help the students for better clinical exposure.

As a part of integrated medical treatment, a state of the art Panchakarma unit is also started providing the service to the needy.

Our Present Swamiji His Holiness Sri Sri Sri Dr Nirmalanandanatha Mahaswamiji has taken this institute to a new height. In order to fulfil the dreams of Sri Sri Sri Dr Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji to provide health care under one roof. He has started Adichunchanagiri Super Specialty Hospital which caters the services in the various super specialties. The department of Neurosurgery was established keeping in mind the number of road traffic accident victims on the Bengaluru-Mangaluru highway. The department is working round the clock to provide services immediately to the patients of RTA and has saved hundreds of lives. Apart from RTA it also provides Surgical services to stroke, tumors, spinal problems and other Neurosurgical patients. The plastic surgery department is doing a lot of Reconstructive surgeries with highly skilled staff and also burns victims in collaboration with Agni Raksha an NGO working for burns victims. The super Specialty hospital also provides the services in the super specialty of Urology, Nephrology, Surgical, Medical & Radiation Oncology and Rheumatology. The interventional cardiac services are started in the month of Nov 2022 and is offering round the clock service. The hospital also provides comprehensive diabetes treatment under diabetes care centre.

All services are provided at a very affordable cost and the hospital has the potential to cater service to the people of nearby districts as per the vision of His Holiness Bairvaikya Padmabushana Sri Sri Sri Dr Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji and Sri Sri Sri Dr Nirmalanandanatha Mahaswamiji

Florence Nightingale OM RRC DStJ was an English social reformer, statistician and the founder of modern nursing. Nightingale came to prominence while serving as a manager and trainer of nurses during the Crimean War, in which she organised care for wounded soldiers at Constantinople. She significantly reduced death rates by improving hygiene and living standards. Nightingale gave nursing a favourable reputation and became an icon of Victorian culture, especially in the persona of "The Lady with the Lamp" making rounds of wounded soldiers at night.

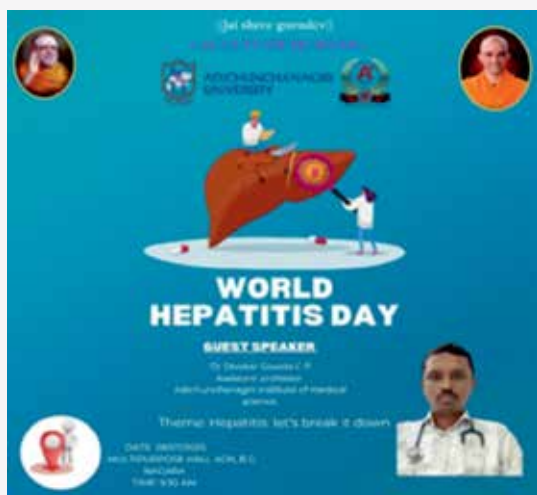
Health Education Talk on Oral Rehydration Solution

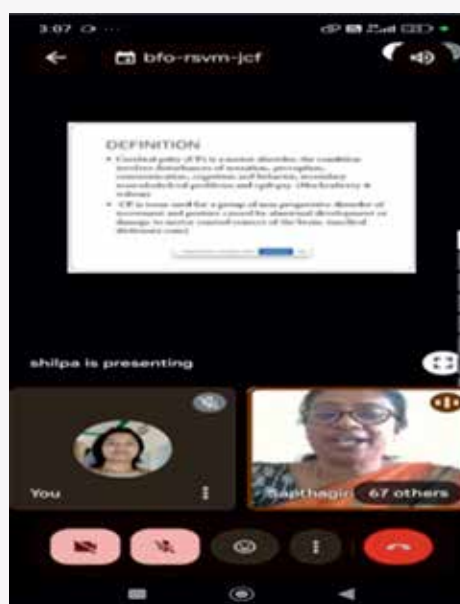

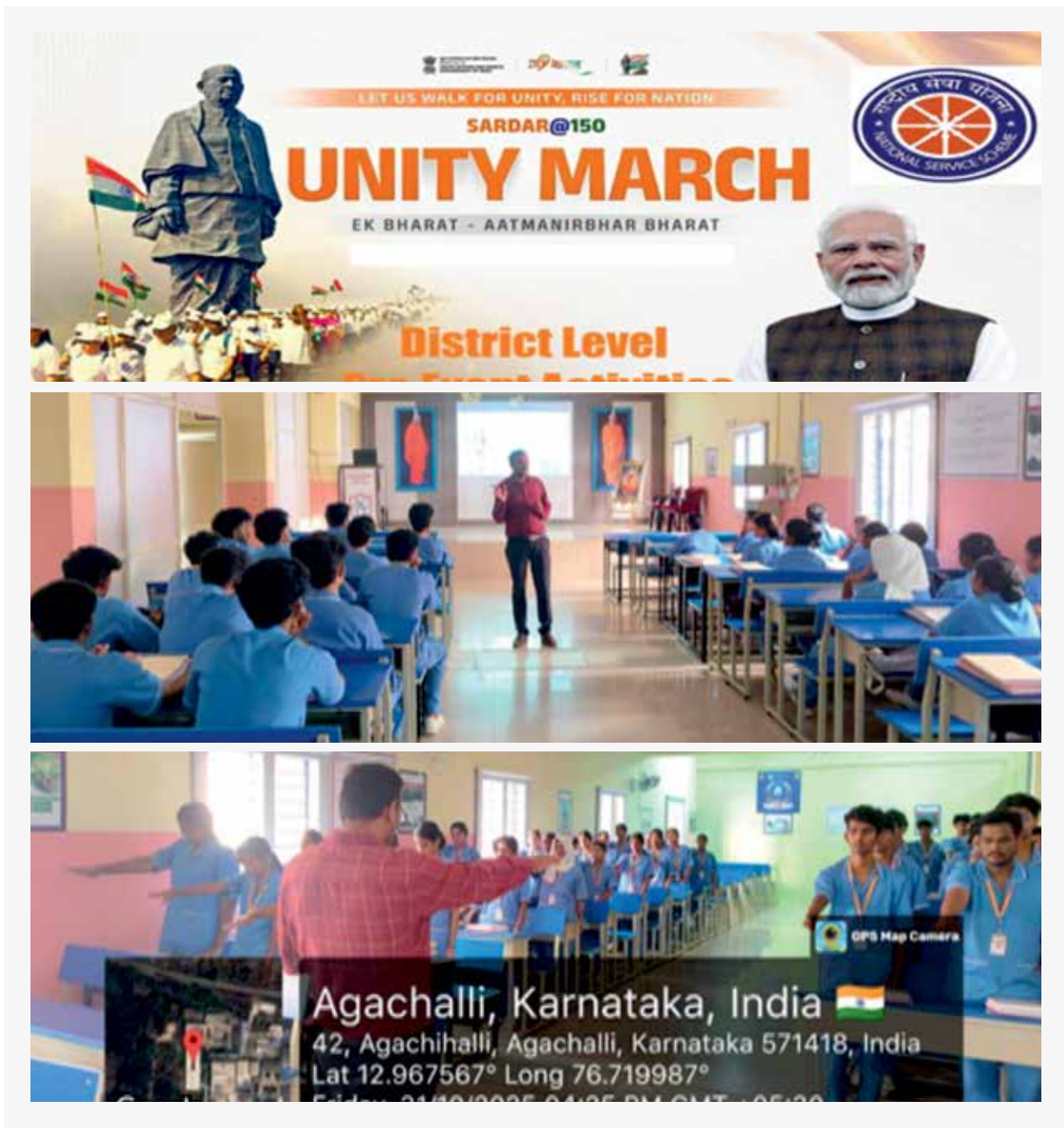

MYTHS AND FACTS ABOUT MENSTRUATION

Myth 1: Menstruation is a disease or illness

Fact: Menstruation is a natural biological process. It is a normal part of a healthy reproductive system and not a disease.

Myth 2: Girls should not attend school or work during menstruation

Fact: Girls can safely attend school, college, and work during menstruation. With proper menstrual hygiene, normal daily activities can be continued.

Myth 3: Physical activity or exercise should be avoided during periods

Fact: Light to moderate exercise can reduce menstrual discomfort, improve mood, and increase blood circulation. Only strenuous activity should be avoided if there is pain or fatigue.

Myth 4: Bathing during menstruation is harmful

Fact: Bathing during menstruation is important for maintaining cleanliness and preventing infection. It helps reduce odor and provides comfort.

Myth 5: Menstrual blood is impure or dirty

Fact: Menstrual blood is simply blood and tissue shed from the uterus. It is not dirty or impure.

Myth 6: Using sanitary pads or tampons causes infertility

Fact: Menstrual products like sanitary pads, tampons, and menstrual cups are safe when used correctly. They do not affect fertility.

Myth 7: Menstruating girls should not enter kitchens or places of worship

Fact: These beliefs are cultural traditions, not scientific facts. Menstruation does not make a person unclean or harmful.

Myth 8: Periods must always be painful

Fact: Mild discomfort is common, but severe pain is not normal. Persistent or intense pain should be discussed with a healthcare provider.

Myth 9: Menstrual cycles should be exactly 28 days

Fact: Normal menstrual cycles can range from 21 to 35 days in adults and may be irregular in adolescents. Variation is normal.

Myth 10: Talking about menstruation is shameful

Fact: Open discussion about menstruation promotes awareness, correct practices, and emotional support. It should be discussed openly and respectfully.

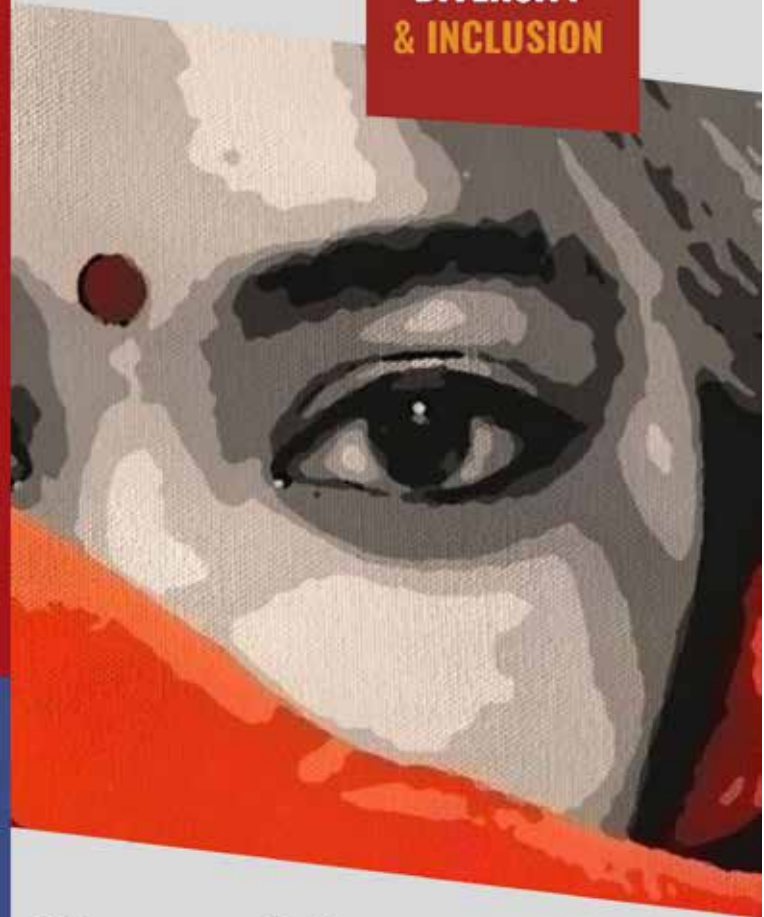
